Jane will also be sharing God's Word and vision which is sure to inspire, encourage, and challenge believers to be bold and step out in faith with the Love of God in their communities and across the world.

More about the Ministry and Projects • • • • •

The Lord at work through the Government and Military

God has many ways of doing His work. The UPDF widows and orphans project is one of them. It is a project under the Uganda Peoples' Defence Force (the army) and the Ugandan Ministry of Defence.

Within the army there are a large number of soldiers who are born again and have regular fellowships in the barracks. Sadly, there are also a number of soldiers dying every day in the war against the rebels and tribal raiders, through HIV, AIDS and other illnesses. This leaves many widows who are suffering, 70% of whom are housewives and mothers. Their children fall out of school and the women are left with AIDS, no income and abandoned.

Joy Turyamureba, herself a retired soldier and widow knew of this situation first hand. As a born-again Christian, Christ's compassion filled her and spurred her to action. She approached President Museveni, the President of Uganda with a proposal for a project supporting the widows and orphans of army personnel. It was approved and given full support by the Government who agreed to pay widows the equivalent of their late husband's full salary so that they could support their children, as well as to assist in the creation of other income generating projects for the widows.

The project is now jointly funded by the Ugandan government and other non-government agencies and donors. It has also opened doors for the Gospel. Jane Francis, of King of Kings Restoration ministry and a volunteer project officer, has also had the opportunity to go into the villages and preach the Gospel from the back of military vehicles while distributing Bibles, mosquito nets and other aid.

Villagers, who were used to seeing army trucks full of soldiers with guns, now saw the same trucks filled with Good News Bibles and much needed aid supplies. It is a tremendous work which has made a great impact on the lives of many, with highly favourable reports about the project reaching the President. During Mission UK 2009 you will have a chance to see a documentary of this ministry in action.

King of Kings Restoration International Ministries

King of Kings Restoration International Ministries was founded by Pastor Jane Francis Cheptegi Kipkorir and her husband, Pastor David Seroney Kipkorir to restore and rebuild what Satan has tried to destroy, and to plant new works in the deserts, desolate and remote places.

Jane Francis herself; former waragi brewer, aspirant nun, and now Pastor and servant of Christ is originally from the remote Eastern Uganda Bukwa District on the border with Kenya, under the shadow of Mount Elgon. Her own childhood experience of abuse, poverty and darkness means she understands the hardship and suffering of the people who live and die in these remote regions of the world. As she says:

"I am now fighting for those who are suffering in the same circumstances I went through. Today God has given me a burden for these remote and desolate villages. I can relate to them; they remind me of where God picked me from. When I see their situation it humbles me and my heart is filled with compassion, which gives me no rest until I do something."

King of Kings has already planted 6 churches in Uganda and Kenya, with land to plant two more. There is also land and a vision for an orphanage and several income-generating projects. Youth ministry and evangelism are two of their primary missions. Through the ministry, regions which were once deserted due to rebel activities and raiders have become peaceful and resettled. Many have been saved, delivered from evil practices, witchcraft and addiction. The Lord is blessing the work with much fruit – and there is an even greater vision to see **the Church in Africa grow and bless others throughout the world with ministry and practical resources – no longer to be beggars but those who bless and give freely.**

* When and Where

The style and type of meeting is flexible - an evening meeting, regular service or even a special event held over several days with teaching and ministry. We need to hear from you regarding your preferred dates as soon as possible, so that we can finalise a workable schedule. William Metzger (Mainstream Ministries) will be joining the team at some events and is available prior to the Mission.

- + **Mission UK dates: from Friday, 18th September to 29th October (6 weeks).**
- + **In addition to speaking/teaching/ministry meetings, the team will be available to meet with church leaders to discuss anything related to the work and ministry.**
- + **The team will be based in Herefordshire initially, but are pleased to travel anywhere in mainland UK for ministry (schedules permitting).**

* Hosting Details

There is no charge or fees for ministry visits or meetings. We would ask that host churches show a warm welcome and hospitality to their guests, remembering that they will receive neither salaries nor other remuneration for this ministry – it is freely given. In that spirit we would request that any church or organisation inviting them to minister consider providing at least the following:

- + **A meal or refreshment before or after the scheduled meeting;**
- + **Assistance with transportation between venues if needed;**
This may be either a contribution towards the cost of transportation or a driver and vehicle.
- + **Overnight accommodation if required;**
This is a particular need if there are several meetings in one region.

If you feel so led, a gift to the ministries and/or those ministering would also be a blessing. However, this is entirely between you and the Lord, and no formal request will be made at anytime.
